SUSTAINABILITY OF FOOD SYSTEMS

- Large-scale industrial agriculture
 - Perceived by local actors as unsustainable
 - Productivism and postproductivism (Holmes 2006)
- Widespread food self-provisioning (gardening)
 - Urban-rural continuum 43–72% of food growers
 - Quiet (unintentional) sustainability (Jehlička et al.)
 - Supplemental character but important part of rural culture
 - Neglected by any current relevant policies (Strategy of Food and Nutrition Security, Conception of Rural Development, EU's From Farm To Fork)
- Coexistence of self-provisioning & mainstream food system
 - Imaginative potential of self-provisioning (values, norms, activities)?









- LAGs as important actors of regional development in rural areas

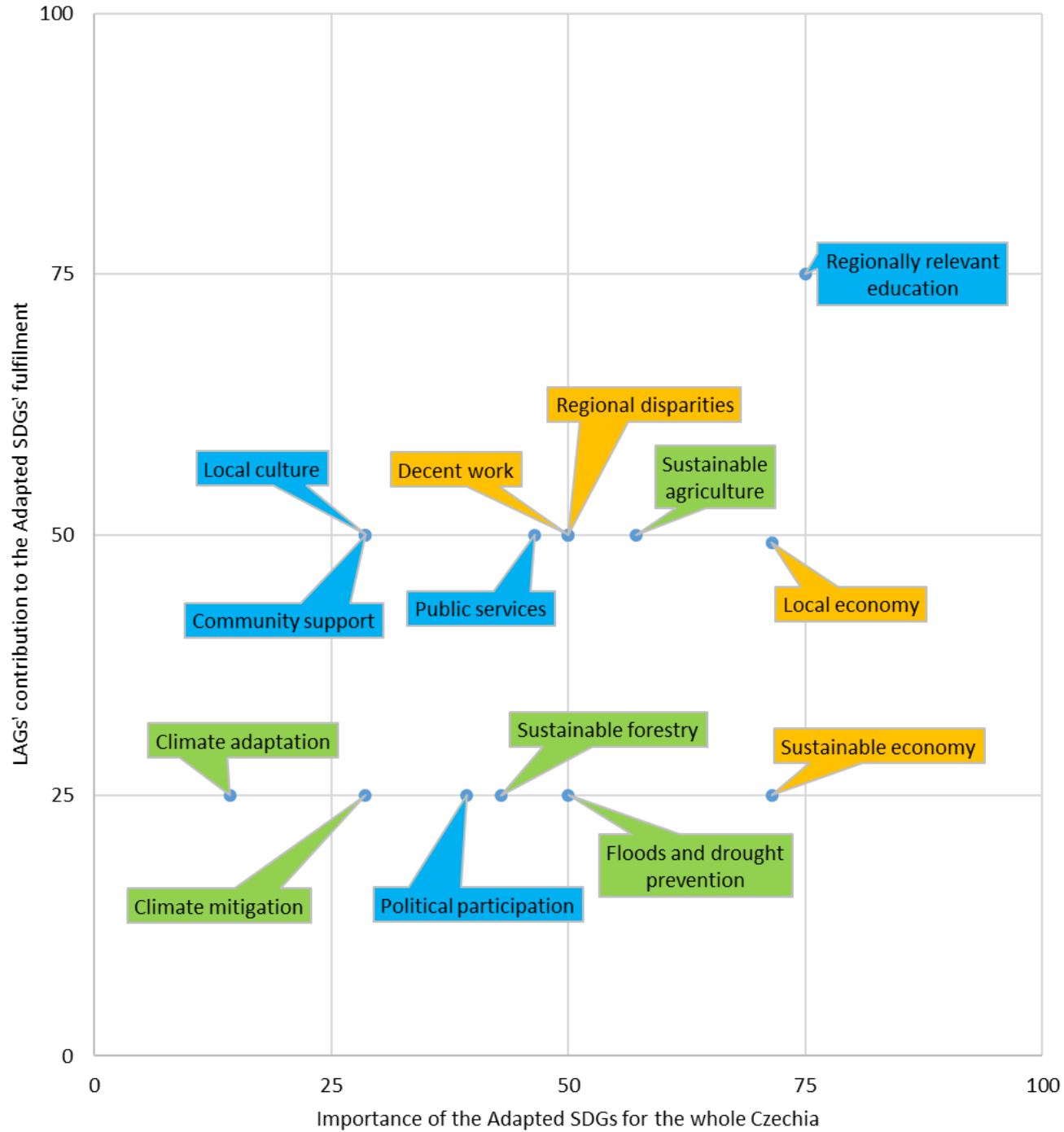
